Health and Education are the wealth of the country. N. S. Memorial College of Nursing, envisioned in 2012 under the management of The Kollam District Co-operative Hospital Society Ltd No.Q952 in continuation to the establishment of the healthcare institution named N S Cooperative Hospital in 2006. NSMCON was aimed to cultivate a new generation, with the knowledge, skill and attitude to provide nursing care to the sick and the disabled and to bring about new innovations in the field of nursing education.

NSMCON is one of the most distinguished institutes in Kerala for training nurses. The college is recognized by Indian Nursing Council (INC), New Delhi, Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council (KNMC), Thiruvananthapuram and affiliated to the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Thrissur, Kerala. The N S Nursing College has six full-fledged departments – Medical Surgical Nursing, Child Health Nursing, Mental Health Nursing, Community Health Nursing, Obstetrics and Gynecological Nursing and Nursing Foundations. At present the college is offering B.Sc. Nursing programme with 60 students' intake.

The college is located in N.H bypass, Palathara, Thattamala, Kollam, Kerala, India which is 7.5 Km away from Kollam bus stand and 6 Km away from Kollam Railway station.

Our hospital is a tribute to Co-operative movements and the late leader, N Sreedharan. The hospital started its functioning since February 2006, built in memory of the renowned politician and humanitarian, Com. N. Sreedharan, popularly known as N.S. The hospital tries to live up to his values.

The administration of NSMIMS is controlled by an eleven member Executive body as per the Co-operative Department rules and regulations. KDCHS owns various institutions including NS Memorial Institute of Medical Sciences (NS Co-operative Hospital), NS Ayurvedic Hospital, NS Geriatric Centre, NS Nursing College, NS Post Graduate Institute for Medical Sciences, NS Diagnostic Centre, NS Drugs & Surgical etc. It is governed by the guiding principles of providing medical services to patients with care, compassion, and commitment.

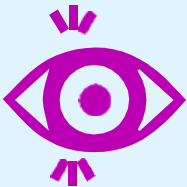
N.S. Memorial Institute of Medical Sciences aims at providing the best of medical facilities and services at affordable cost. The hospital which started as a small venture has undergone remarkable growth in infrastructure facilities and general amenities over the years. More than 1500 patients attend the Outpatient Department daily, which is the largest OPD census second to that of District Hospital, Kollam, shows that the hospital is one among the most popular hospitals in Kollam District. Every year more than 6 lakh patients got benefit from our services and the hospital has become an icon of healthcare in Kerala.

NSMIMS is a 500 bedded Hospital with an outstanding medical team consisting of 130 doctors & 1400 nursing, medical, and paramedical staff with 36 Multi-Super Specialty departments. Our 9 storied super specialty block started with facilities like 1.5T wide bore MRI, 128 Slice multi detector CT and modern cath lab units. It was a dream-like achievement for the society to get accredited by NABH Safe-I. Our hospital got the “Best Co-operative hospital in Kerala” award from the Kerala State government in 2019 and 2020. We are proud to say that our treatment cost is 30% less than our neighboring hospitals. We are providing discount facilities to the economically backward section of the society (AAY) with a reduction of 30% in the overall bill (excluding medicine charges) and a 10% discount on all medicines. The institution stands with a vision to serve the poor. We consider this a sour responsibility to serve the society.

There are almost all the specialty departments with 2-4 units in each department and super specialty departments like Cardiology, Pulmonary medicine, Nephrology, Neonatology, Gastroenterology, Neuro medicine, General surgery, Plastic surgery, Neuro surgery, Reproductive medicine, Fetal medicine etc. More than 100 doctors provide round the clock medical care to patients in the hospital.

COURSE OFFERED

Bachelor of Science-Nursing (B.Sc. Nursing) is a Four years (8 semesters) fulltime course (As per the syllabus of INC and affiliated to KUHS)

DURATION

Duration of the programme shall be four years (Eight semesters). Integrated practice is incorporated with respective practical hours in each semester from Semester I to VII. Eighth Semester is the period of internship, intended for intensive practicum/residency posting.

ALLOCATION OF SEATS

The N.S. Memorial College of Nursing has an annual intake of 60 seats for the B.Sc. (N) course. The details are given below:

- ▶ General Merit-50%(Allotment from Government prepared merit list-LBS allotment)
- ▶ Management Quota-50% (Merit based allotment-online application)

HOW TO APPLY

- A candidate who seeks admission to NS Memorial College of Nursing, Kollam, under the management quota should submit an online application in the website of the college www.nsnursingcollege.in from 25/06/2026 to 25/07/2026
- Application fee of Rs.1000 (including GST) to be remitted through online payment. Application fee once paid will not be refunded.

Along with application form the following should be uploaded.

- Passport size photograph of the candidate taken after 01.01.2026
- Signature of the candidate
- Copy of SSLC certificate
- Mark list of the qualifying examination
- Rank list will be published in the college website on 19.08.2026.
- A candidate who seeks admission to Government merit quota may apply through LBS/other agency endorsed by DME/Government to complete the admission process as per guidelines.

SELECTION

Selection of the candidates will be purely based on merit, according to the marks obtained in the qualifying examination, (Physics, Chemistry & Biology of Second year) a rank list will be prepared and published in the college website. The candidates are requested to verify the marks entered in the website and report to the college mail if any discrepancy noted. Percentage of marks will be calculated for preparing rank list by normalization in different streams. The schedule of admission will be informed through online in the college website.

Resolving of tie while ranking:

In case of a tie in the total marks computed for ranking, candidates with higher marks obtained in Biology (in the final year of the qualifying examination) will be placed higher in the ranking. If tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Chemistry will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Physics will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists the percentage of total marks for plus one and plus two together and then the percentage of marks in English will be considered for breaking the tie. Even after this, if tie remains, the age of the candidate will be taken into account and the older will be placed higher in the ranking than the younger. If the tie still persists, tie will be resolved by criteria as decided by the Selection Committee.

11. Migration Certificate

12. Medical Fitness Certificate from a registered Government Medical practitioner having MBBS or higher qualification
13. Five passport size photo & four stamp size photo with name & date of birth affixed in it, as in SSLC certificate.
14. Under taking regarding non-involvement in ragging
15. Two sets of photo copies of documents from 1 to 9 in the list

It is the responsibility of the candidates to ensure that the qualifying examination he/she has passed is /recognized by the Kerala University of Health Sciences as eligible qualification for admission.

DATE OF ADMISSION

The cutoff date of admission to Nursing Course will be as per the notification issued by the KUHS and Government of Kerala.

FEE STRUCTURE

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission (As per University norms)
- The minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years course), or Senior School Certificate Examination (10+2), Pre-Degree Examination (10+2), or an equivalent with 12 years schooling from a recognized board or University with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) and English with minimum of 50% aggregate marks (as per KUHS & INC norms). The due concessions in the minimum percentage of marks for SC/ST candidates are as per university regulations.
- Candidate should be medically fit.

DISCONTINUATION OF COURSE

Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in our Nursing College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the first year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent "Civil Court."

CURRICULUM

The N.S. Memorial College of Nursing follows the Curriculum prescribed by the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur and Indian Nursing council.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

UNIFORM

- Students are required to wear the uniform prescribed by the college during their class & clinical experience.
- Students should have put up their hair and should wear prescribed footwear only, during clinical experience.
- Students are not allowed to wear any jewellery except small earrings during the clinical experience.

STUDENTS ACTIVITIES

- Students are expected to participate in all the activities organized by the college. Students are encouraged to become members of the Student Nurses Association. The Student Nurses Association will provide a means of personal and professional development for the nursing student.
- To use leisure time creatively and effectively, they are provided with facilities for indoor and outdoor games.
- Educational trips are arranged for the students every year. Educational trips will be charged during the course and students will have to bear the full expense of the trip. Free conveyance may be available for short distance.

CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

- Students are responsible to the Principal for the behavior both in and outside the college.
- Students should maintain silence in the class, library and in the corridors when lectures are in session.
- Students should make every effort to take care of the college, hostel and hospital property.
- Any willful damage done to the property of the college, hostel and hospital will be dealt with as a breach of discipline.
- Students are required to abide by the rules and regulations laid by the hospital, and college authorities. Violation of rules will entail disciplinary action.
- Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards and behaviors.
- Students should not involve themselves in any religious activity publicly in the campus during their tenure in the college
- Students who are found to have major health problems and unable to continue the course viz., cardiac problems, epilepsy, tuberculosis, infectious skin diseases, psychiatric problems or any other major illness will have to discontinue their course based on medical advice and the fees paid will not be refunded.

HEALTH PROGRAMME

Each student will undergo an annual medical checkup. Students will be immunized against infectious diseases as and when necessary. If illness occurs during their course they will be cared for in the hospital on payment.

HOSTEL

Hostel facilities will be provided to the girls and boys as required. Rooms are provided with furniture. Each student must bring bedding/mattress, a pillow, four bed sheets, two pillow covers, an umbrella and a watch with a second hand. They should not bring any valuable jewelry. The college will not take any responsibility for loss or theft. Food will be provided in the hostel. The charges for each month will be fixed. Boarding charges must be paid at the beginning of the academic year.

Parents and students are required to read and sign the hostel rules. The same will be given to the student at the time of admission.

RAGGING

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the college and hostel. All the members of the college are committed to abolish ragging in the campus. Hence any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subject to penal actions as per provisions of law. Also the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned. Students and parents have to submit an undertaking regarding non-involvement in ragging in the given format (online link) at the time of admission.
